RE: Behavioral Health contract amendment with Crestwood Behavioral Health for psychiatric inpatient services

Recommendation

It is respectfully requested that your Board: (1) approve a Behavioral Health contract amendment with Crestwood Behavioral Health for residential psychiatric care; and (2) authorize your Chairman to sign the contract.

Background/Current Situation

The County does not operate inpatient residential facilities and therefore contracts for such placement. Multiple contracts are necessary as beds are in short supply throughout California. If we were to limit the number of contracts, there would almost certainly be a time that someone was in danger to themselves or others, and no bed space would be available.

Due to an increase in patient needs it has become necessary to increase the original contract amount from \$5,500 to \$15,000. This increase will be included in mid-year budget adjustments.

The current contract was reviewed and approved by Rich Benson, CAO on July 20, 2010.

Financial

This contract will continue to be paid within the Mental Health budget unit 0402. The cost will not exceed a total contract amount of \$15,000.

No county general funds are required.
