RECOMMENDED ACTION AND JUSTIFICATION:

Approve Mariposa Public Works (MCPW) Solid Waste & Recycling Division's request to apply for the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) Ranch & Farm Solid Waste Cleanup and Abatement Grant to assist eligible applicants to pay for designated costs of cleanup, abatement, or other remedial actions related to the disposal of illegal solid waste on farm or ranch property.

BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:

The Board of Supervisors has always promoted responsible solid waste management in Mariposa County. The proposed CalRecycle grant would help further that cause by assisting property owners of farm or ranch land with the cleanup of illegal dumpsites on their property. This particular request is for the Stout Ranch located on Silver Land Road. The Stouts have a 22-acre parcel that was purchased with the intent to raise meat goats. The Stouts have removed over 100 cubic yards of solid waste along with several abandoned vehicles and appliances, a camper trailer, and two uninhabitable doublewide mobile homes filled waist-high with trash. This grant will help defray some of the cost incurred while cleaning up the property.

ALTERNATIVES AND CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION:

Currently the County has no funding to assist in disposal costs of illegal dump sites on ranch or farm land. Owners of ranch or farm property could be required to bear the financial burden of cleaning up and abating illegal dumping on their property.



WHEREAS, the people of the State of California have enacted Senate Bill 1330 (Lockyer, Statutes of 1997, Chapter 2.5) which authorizes Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) to award Farm & Ranch Solid Waste Cleanup and Abatement Grants (Grant) to eligible applicants to pay for designated costs of cleanup, abatement, or other remedial action related to the disposal of illegal solid waste on farm or ranch property; and

WHEREAS, the CalRecycle requires as a condition of application that the applicant authorizes by resolution certain matters prior to the submission of the Grant application;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mariposa County Board of Supervisors hereby:



2. Certifies that said applicant has, or will have sufficient funds in addition to funds provided by the grant to complete the project; and


