BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:

On October 24, 2006, the Board of Supervisors authorized the Business Development Coordinator to proceed with the development on the **Project Design Phase** of a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Planning/Technical Assistance (PTA) to develop a drainage study for the town of Mariposa (3rd – 5th Streets) and an Environmental Overview on the above-referenced areas.

On November 28, 2006, a Public Hearing was held for the *Application Submittal Phase* of the PTA. The Board approved the grant application, which was subsequently submitted to HCD.

On February 12, 2008, the County Board of Supervisors approved Agreement No. 06-STBG-2609 with HCD.

On January 13, 2009, the Board of Supervisors approved a Professional Services Agreement with Roger Stephens Engineering in the amount of \$32,250, to conduct a Drainage Study for the town of Mariposa (3rd to 5th Street); resulting in the commencement of the project on January 27, 2009.

On May 26, 2009, the Board of Supervisors approved a Professional Services Agreement with Analytical Environmental Services (AES) in the amount of \$31,000 to conduct an Environmental Overview in the above-referenced areas for stormwater facility improvements.

On June 18, 2009, AES, Public Works and Economic Development staff convened to discuss pre-construction, Scope of Work and timeline.

Contained in this report are documents reflecting the Drainage Study for the town of Mariposa (3rd – 5th Street) – Exhibit "A"; an Environmental Overview on the above-referenced project areas – Exhibit "B"; Negative Declaration and Initial Study – Exhibit "C"; Closeout Certification Form – Exhibit "D"; Summary Reports – Exhibit "E"; and Authorized Signature Card Form – Exhibit "F".

The Public Hearing Notice was published on April 15, 2010, as Exhibit "G".

On December 15, 2009, the Board of Supervisors approved the Negative Declaration, Initial Study and Environmental Overview on the above-referenced project areas described on the attached "Recommended Action and Justification Section of the Agenda Transmittal Form," however, these documents were not approved through the Public Hearing process as mandated by HCD. Therefore, these documents are hereby resubmitted for "acceptance" in this "Grant Closeout Process".

Negative Impact:

Not "accepting" the requested action will result in negative impacts relative to Agreement 06-STBG-2609, between the State of California Department of Housing and Community Development and County of Mariposa that would place the County in "Hold Out Status" causing the County to be ineligible to apply for CDBG grants.
