RECOMMENDED ACTION AND JUSTIFICATION:

Recommend resolution adopting the Mariposa County Hazardous Materials Incident Response Plan ("Area Plan") and direct staff to append the Area Plan to the County Emergency Response Plan.

BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:

California Law (Health & Safety Code Sections 25500, et. Seq.) and Regulations promulgated by the State Office of Emergency Services require such a plan for each local agency regulating Hazardous Materials (in this County, the Health Department).

There has been a draft Plan for some time, but this Plan requires the interaction of multiple agencies and agreement about agency jurisdictions. After a series of meetings, these jurisdictional elements have been worked out, allowing us to request the Board's approval of the Plan and incorporation into the County's overall Emergency Response Plan.

ALTERNATIVES AND CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION:

The "Area Plan" will remain informal, without Board adoption.

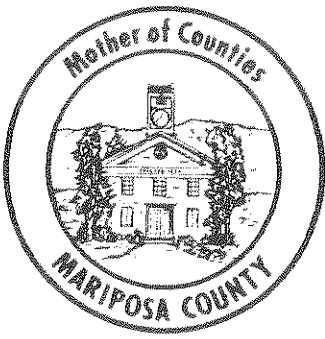

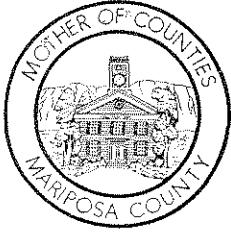

SUBJECT: Haz Mat Incident Response Plan

The binder is large, but here are the most important points:

1. We have achieved agreement on agencies' responsibilities and jurisdictions (see pages 1-25 and appendix #7).
2. This Plan is consistent with California Law and compatible with other Counties' Plans in our OES Region.
3. The Plan is designed to work for hazardous materials utilized by businesses within the County, for those transported through the County, for illegal hazardous materials, and for air-borne hazardous materials like pesticides and toxic smoke.
4. Response is based upon the Incident Command System (IC), which is known by responding County, State, and Federal agencies.
5. Like similar documents, this Plan is subject to review and modification, as needed.
