RE: Apply for CUPA UST Grant Funding

RECOMMENDATION AND JUSTIFICATION:

Authorize Health Officer to Apply for a Rural Underground Storage Tank (UST) Prevention Program Grant in the Amount of \$84,949 over Two Fiscal Years and to Sign Agreement if Awarded; Authorize the Health Officer to sign Application for Subsequent Fiscal Year, other Amendments or Revisions as needed, Subject to Approval as to Form by County Counsel.

This Grant is to Subsidize Staff Training and Inspection Activities in the UST Program. It is not available to jurisdictions of populations greater than 150,000.

BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:

The Board has previously authorized applying for this program (September 27, 2011 with Res. No. 11-470, and on June 11, 2013 with Res. No. 13-229).

ALTERNATIVES AND CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION:

Do not approve applying for the Grant. Program funds would need to come from the General Fund.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:


If awarded the grant will bring in revenue of \$84,949 over two fiscal years to subsidize staff training and inspection activities related to Underground Storage Tanks.
