RE: Fill Anticipated Vacancy in the District Attorney's Office

RECOMMENDATION AND JUSTIFICATION:

Approve the Immediate Filling of a Deputy District Attorney I, II, III Position Within the District Attorney's Office. A Deputy District Attorney II within the District Attorney's (DA) Office has submitted a letter of intent to resign effective July 18, 2014. The incumbent has accepted a position in another County.

The filling of the Deputy District Attorney I, II, III position is of priority interest. The District Attorney is requesting that the Board authorize filling this position at either the I, II, or III level even though the vacant allocation is a Deputy District Attorney III. This will give the department flexibility as there is a current eligibility list available with several well-qualified Deputy District Attorney I, II, and III candidates from which to choose. If the successful candidate is at either the I or II level, the department will return to the Board to request a change in the position allocation from a Deputy District Attorney III to a Deputy District Attorney I/II.

The Deputy District Attorney position is a fully funded budgeted position within the DA Prosecution budget and will have no additional impact to the General Fund. This position is represented by the Mariposa County Managerial and Confidential Organization (MCMCO).

BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:

The Board of Supervisors has previously filled fully funded / budgeted vacant positions at the request of the Department Head.

ALTERNATIVES AND CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION:


If the Board chooses to not allow the filling of this position, this may have a negative impact on community public safety and hinder the ability of the District Attorney to protect our community and deliver justice.
