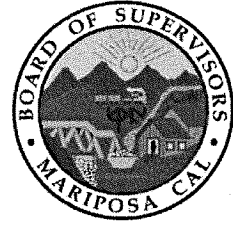

RE: Authorize the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors to Sign a Letter of Intent to Accept State Grant

RECOMMENDATION AND JUSTIFICATION:

Authorize the Board of Supervisors Chair to Sign a Letter of Intent to Accept State Grant Funding Pursuant to the Budget Act of 2014 (Chapter 25, Statutes of 2014). The Budget Act of 2014 allocates \$8 million to the Board of State and Community Corrections (BSCC) to administer the Community Recidivism Reduction Grant program that can provides funding to local community based organizations for a wide range of programs that support the Community Corrections Partnership (CCP) Plans.

Counties are eligible to receive funds if the Board of Supervisors (BOS), in collaboration with the County's CCP, agrees to develop a competitive grant program intended to fund community recidivism and crime reduction services. Mariposa County is eligible to receive a one time grant amount of \$10,000. The Mariposa County CCP Executive Committee is supportive of accepting the funding.

In developing the grant program the BOS, in collaboration with the CCP must establish minimum requirements, funding criteria, grant award limits, and procedures for the County to award grants. The State will require the County to report back to it on the number of individuals served and the types of services rendered. The Probation Department in support of the CCP will administer the grant.

In order to receive the funding a letter of intent to receive the funds must be sent to the BSCC by September 30, 2014.

BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:

The Board has previously supported grant opportunities for community based organizations.

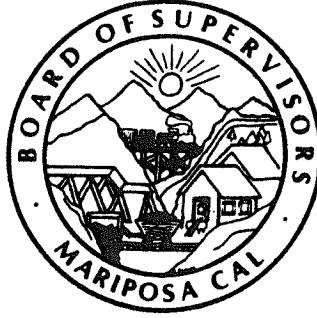
