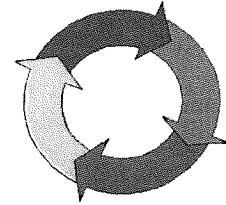



RE: Child Abuse Prevention, Intervention, and Treatment (CAPIT) & Community Based Family Resource and Support (CBFRS) Funding

RECOMMENDATION AND JUSTIFICATION

To continue receiving funding, it is respectfully recommended that your Board:

1. Authorize the Department of Human Services to submit a Notice of Intent and application to the State Department of Social Services (Office of Child Abuse Prevention) for Child Abuse Prevention, Intervention, and Treatment (CAPIT), and Community Based Family Resource and Support (CBFRS) funding for the 2002-2005 grant cycle;
2. Authorize the Department of Human Services to release Request for Proposals in Spring 2002 for community organizations to apply for these funds;
3. Designate the Department of Human Services (Community Action Programs) to administer these prevention programs;
4. Authorize the Department of Human Services (Community Action Programs), to develop a three-year plan that administratively integrates CAPIT and CBFRS, as required by the Office of Child of Abuse Prevention, in conjunction with the Family Preservation and Support Program Planning Group; and
5. Upon approval of County Counsel and the CAO, authorize the Human Services Director to execute subsequent amendments to this agreement with the State Department of Social Services, Office of Child Abuse Prevention.

BACKGROUND

Mariposa County has received CAPIT/CBFRS funding for fifteen years. CAPIT funds have largely been contracted to Kingsview. CBFRS has been contracted to community organizations that provide child abuse prevention and family services.

CURRENT SITUATION

Mariposa County relies on these monies to fund programs for children who have been abused and/or neglected and for family services. To continue to bring these monies into the County, your Board can authorize the notice of intent and application to receive funding for 2002-2005. Your Board will be presented with requests for funding and asked to approve recommended allotments after Family Preservation and Support Program Planning Group review.

This is a State funded program. No County match is required. The anticipated 2002-2005 allocations available to Mariposa County are \$74,539 (CAPIT) and \$31,266 (CBFRS) annually.
