MARIPOSA COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 994

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2.104.050 OF
CHAPTER 2.104 OF THE MARIPOSA COUNTY CODE**

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors desire to amend Section 2.104.050 of Chapter 2.104 of the Mariposa County Code, and

WHEREAS, amending Section 2.104.050 will make the language in the County Code consistent with the language contained in the California Children and Families First Act,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MARIPOSA COUNTY, a political subdivision of the State of California, does ordain as follows:


SECTION I: Section 2.104.050 of Chapter 2.104 of the Mariposa County Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

2.104.050 Membership. The commission shall consist of seven (7) members. The membership shall consist of one (1) member of the Board of Supervisors, the Department Of Human Services Director or his/her designee, The County Health Officer or his/her designee, one (1) member who is a recipient of project services included in the county strategic plan; one (1) initial term of two (2) years: member, recipient of project services; member, representative of the Mariposa County Unified School District. The following shall have an initial term of one member who is an educator specializing in early childhood development; one (1) member who is a representative of Mariposa County Unified School District, and a representative of a local childcare resource or referral agency, or a local childcare coordinating group.

SECTION II: This Ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days after final passage pursuant to Government Code §25123.


