1 MARIPOSA COUNTY ORDINANCE 519 2 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE MARIPOSA COUNTY CODE BY ADDING A NEW SECTION TO CHAPTER 12.04 THEREOF RELATING TO COUNTY ROADS 3 4 The Board of Supervisors of the County of Mariposa, State of 5 California, do hereby ordain as follows: 6 SECTION I: Chapter 12.04, County Roads, is amended by adding a new 7 section thereto to read in its entirety as follows: 8 12.04.080 Closing or Restricting the Use of County Highways. The Mariposa County Road Commissioner, pursuant to Government Code §942.6, 9 shall have the delegated powers contained in Government Code §942.5 as follows: 10 The Mariposa County Road Commissioner may restrict the use of, or 11 close, any County highway whenever the Road Commissioner considers such closing or restriction of use necessary: 12 (a) For the protection of the public. 13 (b) For the protection of such County highway from damage during 14 storms. 15 (c) During construction, improvement, or maintenance operations thereon. 16 No liability shall attach to the County, or to the Road Commissioner, for the restriction of use, or closing, of any County highway for the 17 above public purposes. 18 19 SECTION II: This ordinance is an urgency ordinance to protect the public safety, health, and welfare and shall take effect immediately pursuant 20 to the provisions of Government Code §36934 and §36937. The facts constituting 21 the urgency relate to preserving the health and safety of persons utilizing 22 County highways. 23
