AN ORDINANCE TO SET COMPENSATION FOR  
PLANNING COMMISSION MEMBERS BY RESOLUTION

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS of Mariposa County, a political sub-  
division of the State of California, does hereby ordain as follows:


SECTION I: Section 2.52.100 of the Mariposa County Code is  
hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

2.52.100 Compensation. Members of the planning commission  
shall receive such compensation as shall be determined by resolu-  
tion of the Board of Supervisors and such resolution shall also  
determine mileage reimbursement and the compensation of the secre-  
tary of the commission for attendance at commission meetings out-  
side normal working hours.

SECTION II: This ordinance shall become effective THIRTY (30)  
days from the date of final passage pursuant to Government Code  
Section 25123.

The commission shall not consider any matter which does not appear on the agenda except as follows: matter referred by the board if supervisors may be considered upon consent of a majority of the members present and any other matter may be considered upon the unanimous consent of the members present. (Ord. 411 §1, 1975; Ord. 387 §7(d), 1974).

2.52.100 Compensation. Members of the planning commission shall receive the following compensation:

A. Each member shall receive thirty dollars per meeting plus mileage at the current rate set by the board of supervisors.

B. Each member shall receive mileage for trips made in connection with the performance of his duties.

C. Each member shall receive while on official duties in connection with planning commission other than regular

meetings the following: for less than one-half day, he shall receive fifteen dollars; for one-half day or more, he shall receive thirty dollars.

D. In addition to such other compensation authorized pursuant to Mariposa County Salary Resolution No. 74-58(R) and periodic amendments made thereto, the secretary of the commission shall receive fifteen dollars for each planning commission meeting or planning function said secretary is required to be present at outside of normal working hours. (Ord. 535 §§1, 2, 1980; Ord. 396, 1975; Ord. 387 §8, 1974).

2.52.110 Appointment of chairman, vice-chairman and secretary. The commission shall elect a chairman and vice-chairman from among its members. The chairman and vice-chairman serve for a term of one year and until the successor of each is appointed and qualified. The commission shall appoint a secretary who need not be a member of the commission. (Ord. 387 §9, 1974).

2.52.120 Adoption of rules. The commission shall adopt rules for the transaction of its business and shall keep a public record of its resolutions, transactions, findings and determinations. (Ord. 387 §10, 1974).

2.52.130 Duties and powers. In addition to the duties, rights and powers imposed by state law, the commission shall perform the duties, and has the rights, powers and privileges provided by ordinance or resolution of the board of supervisors. (Ord. 387 §11, 1974).

2.52.140 Quorum. Five members of the commission constitutes a quorum for the transaction of business. (Ord. 387 §12, 1974).

2.52.150 Duties of chairman. The chairman shall preside at all meetings of the commission. He shall appoint all committees and shall perform all the duties necessary or incidental to his office. (Ord. 387 §13(a), 1974).

2.52.160 Vice-chairman. The vice-chairman is chairman in the absence or inability of the chairman to act. (Ord. 387 §13(b), 1974).
