

1 MARIPOSA COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 569

2 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 18.02.050  
3 SURFACE MINING AND RECLAMATION

4 THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS of Mariposa County, a political sub-  
5 division of the State of California, does hereby ordain as follows:

6 SECTION I: Subparagraph B of Section 18.020.050 of the Mari-  
7 posa County Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

8 18.02.050 Exceptions. The provisions of this chapter shall  
9 not apply to any of the following activities: ...

10 B. Prospecting for or the extraction of minerals for commer-  
11 cial purposes and the removal of overburden in total amounts of  
12 less than one thousand cubic yards in any one location of one acre  
13 or less or in any case where either (1) a project is determined to  
14 be on-site construction and a grading permit is required by the  
15 county building code or (2) TAC determines that the operation will  
16 be of an infrequent nature and involve only minor surface distur-  
17 bances and is categorically identified by the State Mining and Ge-  
18 ology Board pursuant to Sections 2714(d) and 2758(c) of the Cali-  
19 fornia Surface Mining and Reclamation Act of 1975. The county  
20 planning office and the county building official shall be responsi-  
21 ble for conducting periodic inspections of surface mining operations.

22 SECTION II: Pursuant to Government Code Section 25123, this  
23 ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days after final pass-  
24 age.


