

1 MARIPOSA COUNTY ORDINANCE No. 586

2 SETTING A REFERENDUM ELECTION ON THE ISSUE
3 OF LOW RENT HOUSING FOR SENIOR CITIZENS
4 IN MARIPOSA COUNTY

5 WHEREAS, Article XXXIV of the Constitution of the State of
6 California requires that low rent housing projects developed,
7 constructed or acquired in any manner by any state public body
8 be approved by a majority vote of qualified voters in the county
9 voting on the issue; and

10 WHEREAS, persons wishing to develop low rent housing for
11 senior citizens in Mariposa County seek to utilize funding avail-
12 able through governmental agencies, contingent upon approval of
13 such projects by the voters;

14 NOW THEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of Mariposa County
15 does hereby ordain as follows:

16 SECTION I: It is hereby ordered and directed that a refer-
17 endum Low Rent Senior Citizen Housing Election be consolidated
18 with the November 1982 General Election, to be known as the "Mari-
19 posa County Referendum Low Rent Senior Citizen Housing Election."

20 SECTION II: It is hereby ordered and directed that the
21 exact wording of the housing measure to be placed upon the ballot
22 and voted upon at such Referendum Election shall be as follows:


23 "Shall the County of Mariposa, through
24 the Board of Supervisors, allow for the
25 development and construction within the
26 County of Mariposa, with federal financial
27 assistance, of low rent housing, not to
28 exceed 100 dwelling units, for living accom-
modations for elderly persons of low income?"

SECTION III: This ordinance setting the referendum election shall become effective immediately upon final passage pursuant to Elections Code Section 3751.


