RE: Juvenile Defense Attorney Services Agreement

RECOMMENDATION AND JUSTIFICATION:

Approve the Juvenile Defense Attorney Services Agreement with the Mariposa County Superior Court, and Authorize the Board of Supervisors Chair to Sign the Agreement; Approve Budget Action Increasing Revenue and Appropriations in the Indigent Defense Budget to Correspond with Agreement Amount (\$5,828). Approving the Agreement will ensure that juvenile dependency legal services are provided and that the Superior Court will pay the County for these services. The Court Executive Officer has determined that the amount of money the Mariposa County Superior Court will receive this fiscal year is \$38,070, which is based on the anticipated number of juvenile dependency cases. This is an increase from the previous Agreement and the Superior Court Judges are amenable with this amount.

At the time of budget preparation the allocation amount has not been calculated so last year's Agreement amount was used in the budget. The budget action increases revenue and appropriations in the Indigent Defense budget to recognize the now know funding allocation and the amount included in the Agreement.

BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:

On December 2, 2014, the Board adopted Resolution #14-616 approving the Juvenile Defense Attorney Services Agreement with the Mariposa County Superior Court in the amount of \$32,242.

On July 7, 2015, the Board adopted Resolution #15-316 approving an Amendment increasing the funding allocation for the Juvenile Attorney Services Agreement by \$621.

ALTERNATIVES AND CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION:

Do not approve the Juvenile Defense Attorney Services Agreement. The County may

not receive payment from the Superior Court for providing juvenile dependency legal services.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

Revenue and appropriations will be increased by \$5,828 to correspond with the allocation amount included in the Juvenile Defense Attorney Services Agreement.
