

ORDINANCE NO. 200

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Mariposa do ordain as follows:

County Ordinance No. 177 is hereby amended by adding to Paragraph 4 of Section IX thereof the following:

"Any violation of any of the rules and regulations authorized by this Ordinance, unless otherwise provided by the Board of Supervisors, shall be a misdemeanor and shall be punishable by a fine of not more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) or imprisonment for not exceeding six (6) months, or both.

Such rules and regulations shall be effective thirty (30) days after approval of the Board of Supervisors and shall be posted at the entrance or entrances to recreational areas and facilities owned, controlled or leased by the County of Mariposa, within thirty (30) days after approval thereof."

15 POWERS AND DUTIES

16 The Commission shall have the following powers and  
17 duties:

- 18 1. Act in an advisory capacity to the Board of Super-  
19 visors in promoting, aiding, encouraging and conducting  
20 public recreation, including the development of recrea-  
21 tion and park facilities and programs.
- 22 2. At the request of the Board of Supervisors, recom-  
23 mend to the Board the names of candidates who are qual-  
24 ified in the administration of public recreation services  
25 for appointment by the Board to the position of Director  
26 of Recreation and Parks.
- 27 3. Act in an advisory capacity to the Board of Supervis-  
28 ors and to the Director of Recreation and Parks in the  
29 planning, maintenance, development and operation of all  
30 recreation areas and facilities owned, controlled, or  
31 leased by the County of Mariposa.
- 32 4. Formulate, and recommend to the Board, general

policies related to the purposes of the Commission;  
and adopt by-laws, rules, and regulations, subject to  
the approval of the Board, as the Commission may require  
to facilitate the operation of a recreation and Parks  
system.

5. At the request of the Board of Supervisors, cause a  
budget to be prepared and submitted to the Board annual-  
ly, on or before the first day of July in the same  
manner as other county office budgets are prepared  
providing for the costs of maintenance and operation of  
the recreation and park facilities and programs for the  
ensuing year. The budget shall contain estimates and  
recommendations for such long term capital outlay pro-  
jects as may be necessary to provide for an orderly  
development of recreation and park areas and facilities.

6. Study and make recommendations on the acquisition  
and development of recreation areas and facilities, such  
as playgrounds, parks, beaches, pools, campsites, con-  
cessions and other centers of recreation.

7. Interpret the function and operation of recreation  
and park services to public officials and to the general  
public to the end that the services receive adequate  
financial support from public and private sources.
