ORDINANCE NO. 110.

An Ordinance to Amend Ordinance No. 106 entitled "An Ordinance providing for the salaries, fees and expenses of County Officers, and providing for the salaries and number of deputies."

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Mariposa, State of California, do ordain as follows:

Section 1 of Ordinance No. 106 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. County Clerk.

The County Clerk may appoint a deputy County Clerk, whose salary shall be Nine Hundred Dollars per annum, payable as the salaries of all county officials.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall be in force and effect on January 1st, 1937.
