ORDINANCE NO. 112.

An Ordinance to Amend Ordinance No. 106 entitled "An Ordinance providing for the salaries, fees and expenses of County Officers, and providing for the salaries and number of deputies."

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Mariposa, State of California, do ordain as follows:

Section 5 of Ordinance No. 106 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 5, Treasurer. The County Treasurer may appoint a deputy County Treasurer, whose salary shall be One Hundred twenty Dollars per annum, payable as the salaries of all county officials.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall be in force and effect in thirty days after its passage.
