

ORDINANCE No. 113.

1  
2 An ordinance to Amend Ordinances No. 106, 107 and 109  
3 entitled "An Ordinance providing for the salaries, fees and  
4 expenses of County Officers, and providing for the salaries and  
5 number of deputies."

6 The Board of Supervisors of the County of Mariposa, State  
7 of California, do ordain as follows:

8 Section 4 of Ordinance No. 107 is hereby amended to read  
9 as follows:

10 The Auditor of the County of Mariposa, State of California,  
11 is hereby allowed to appoint a deputy auditor, whose salary shall  
12 be Eighteen Hundred Dollars per annum, payable as the salaries of  
13 all county officers are paid.

14 Section IX of Ordinance No. 107 is amended to read as  
15 follows:

16 Justice of the Peace of No One Township, the sum of  
17 Four Hundred Twenty Dollars, payable in equal monthly installments.

18 Justice of the Peace of No. Two Township, the sum of  
19 Four Hundred Twenty Dollars per annum, payable in equal monthly  
20 installments.

21 Justice of the Peace of No. Three Township the sum of  
22 Nine Hundred Dollars per annum, payable in equal monthly  
23 installments.

24 Justice of the Peace of No. Four Township the sum of  
25 Nine Hundred Dollars, payable in equal monthly installments.

26 Justice of the Peace of No. Five Township the sum of  
27 Four Hundred Twenty Dollars, payable in equal monthly installments.

28 Justice of the Peace of No. Six Township, the sum of  
29 Four Hundred Twenty Dollars, payable in equal monthly installments.

30 Section X of Ordinance No 107 is amended to read as  
31 follows:

32 Constable No. One Township, the sum of Four Hundred Twenty

1 Dollars, payable in equal monthly installments.

2 Constable No. Two Township, the sum of Six Hundred Dollars  
3 payable in equal monthly installments.

4 Constable No. Three Township, the sum of Four Hundred  
5 Twenty Dollars, payable in equal monthly installments,

6 Constable No. Four Township, the sum of Nine Hundred  
7 Dollars, payable in equal monthly installments.

8 Constable No Five Township, the sum of Four Hundred  
9 Twenty Dollars, payable in equal monthly installments.

10 Constable No Six Township, the sum of Four Hundred Twenty  
11 Dollars, payable in equal monthly installments.

12 Section 8 of Ordinance No 106 is hereby amended to  
13 read as follows:

14 Section 8. The District Attorney of the County of Mariposa,  
15 State of California, is hereby allowed a stenographer at a salary  
16 of Thirteen Hundred Twenty Dollars per annum, payable as the  
17 salaries of other county officials.

18 Section XI of Ordinance 107 is Amended to read as follows:

19 The Director of Public Welfare is hereby allowed a salary  
20 of eighteen hundred dollars per annum, payable in equal monthly  
21 installments, payable as the salaries of all county officers are  
22 paid.

23 The Director of Public Welfare shall be allowed travelling  
24 expenses in a sum not to exceed three hundred dollars per annum  
25 in the discharge of his or her official duties, which sum shall  
26 be paid upon presentation of duly verified claims filed with the  
27 Board of Supervisors of said county in the same manner as other  
28 claims are filed and paid.

29 The Director of Public Welfare shall be allowed an  
30 assistant at a salary of Thirteen Hundred Twenty Dollars per  
31 annum payable in equal monthly installments.

32 All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith  
are hereby repealed.
