ORDINANCE NO. 119

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AND FIXING BOUNTY RATES TO ENCOURAGE THE DESTRUCTION OF CERTAIN WILD ANIMALS IN THE COUNTY OF MARIPOSA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

The Board of Supervisors of Mariposa County, State of California, do ordain as follows:

Every person who kills any coyote shall receive a bounty of \$2.00 for it; and every person who kills any wild cat shall receive a bounty of \$1.00 for it.

All claims for bounties hereunder shall be certified to show that the animal or animals claimed to have been killed, were killed in the County of Mariposa on or after August 21, 1941.

The word "person" as used in this ordinance shall be defined to be any person who is a bona fide resident of Mariposa County, California.

Any person killing any of the animals heretofore mentioned must bring the scalps of such animal or animals before any member of the Board of Supervisors of Mariposa County, California or the County Clerk of Mariposa County, California, within two weeks after the killing of said animals.

Such claims shall in every case be accompanied by the scalps of such animals killed and such scalps shall consist of the skin of the top and front part of the head, including the ears intact.

The person killing any animal or animals heretofore mentioned must swear that he or she killed the animal or animals.

All claims allowed in pursuance of this ordinance are payable out of the General Expense Fund.

Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor. A reward of \$50.00 is hereby offered by the Board of Supervisors of Mariposa County for the arrest and conviction of any person or persons violating any of the terms of this ordinance.

This ordinance shall take effect on and after thirty days of its passage and remain in effect until the further order of the Board of Supervisors.
