ORDINANCE NO. 125

ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF MARIPOSA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Mariposa, State of California, do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to the statutes of 1937, Chapter 717, as amended by the Statutes of 1941, Chapter 341, there is hereby created in the office of the County Treasurer a fund for capital outlay.

Section 2. Taxes may be levied and collected at the same time and in the same manner as county taxes for the above named fund.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be published once in the Mariposa Gazette, a newspaper of general circulation in the County of Mariposa within fifteen days after its final passage.

This ordinance shall be in effect thirty days from and after the date of its adoption.

The foregoing ordinance was duly and regularly passed and adopted by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Mariposa, State of California, at a regular meeting held on the 7th day of August, 1944, by the following vote, to-wit:
