

ORDINANCE NO. 135

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 129

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Mariposa, State of California, do ordain as follows:

Paragraph 2 of Section 3 of Ordinance No. 129 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"The Tax Collector may appoint one deputy or hire one clerk when in his opinion it is necessary. The salary paid such deputy or clerk shall not exceed One Hundred Twenty Dollars (\$120.00) per month or a total sum of Nine Hundred Dollars (\$900.00) in any one year.

All ordinances now in force in the County of Mariposa in-so far as the same are in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after thirty days after its passage. The Clerk of the Board of Supervisors is hereby authorized and directed to cause this ordinance to be published in the Mariposa Gazette, a newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the County of Mariposa, State of California, for at least one week prior to fifteen days after its passage.
