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ORDINANCE NO. 136

An Ordinance to Amend Ordinance No. 123, known as the "Salary Ordinance of 1943".

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Mariposa, State of California, do ordain as follows:

Section 3 of Ordinance No. 123 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"The salary of the sheriff shall be Three Thousand Eight Hundred (\$3800.00) Dollars per annum, and such mileage as allowed by law for the service of all papers issued by Courts outside this county, and all mileage and fees for the service of papers in civil cases in this county and such fees as are allowed by this ordinance for expenses incurred in criminal cases.

"The sheriff may appoint a deputy sheriff, whose salary shall be Two Thousand Four Hundred (\$2400.00) Dollars per annum, payable as the salary of all county officials."

All ordinances now in force in the County of Mariposa insofar as the same are in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after thirty days from its passage. The Clerk of the Board of Supervisors is hereby authorized and directed to cause this ordinance to be published in the Mariposa Gazette, a newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the County of Mariposa, State of California, for at least one week prior to fifteen days after its passage.
