

**A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING DEDICATIONS OF PUBLIC ACCESS EASEMENTS**

**BY PARCEL MAP FOR EDWARD KONOPACKI**

WHEREAS, that certain map entitled "PARCEL MAP for EDWARD KONOPACKI", recorded July 30, 1981 in Book 19 of Parcel Maps at Page 9, offered dedications of non-exclusive public utility and access easements along that certain non-county road now known as La Rosa Road,

AND WHEREAS, Section 66477.2 of the Government Code of the State of California allows for the acceptance of dedications by Parcel Map after the map has been recorded, provided that the Board passes and records resolutions of acceptance,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mariposa County Board of Supervisors, a political subdivision of the State of California, that the Board:

1. Accept, on behalf of the public, the dedications of public utility easements, as shown on said map;
2. Accept, on behalf of the public, for public access, but not for maintenance, the dedications along that certain non-county road now known as La Rosa Road, as shown on said map; and
3. Authorizes the recordation of this Acceptance of Dedication.
