

MARIPOSA COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 89-507

WAIVING THE FORMAL BIDDING REQUIREMENTS PURSUANT
TO SECTION 20150.4 OF THE PUBLIC CONTRACTS CODE
AND APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF A FACTORY
MANUFACTURED RESTROOM

WHEREAS, the people of the State of California have enacted the California Wildlife, Coastal and Park Land Conservation Act of 1984, and

WHEREAS, the County of Mariposa Board of Supervisors, a political subdivision of the State of California, desires to provide a public restroom for Midpines Park utilizing California Wildlife, Coastal and Park Land Conservation funds, and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works, Mariposa County, has surveyed the factory manufactured restroom market and obtained prices from three vendors,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mariposa County Board of Supervisors hereby:

1. Waives formal bidding requirements pursuant to Section 20150.4 of the Public Contracts Code,
2. Appoints the Director of Public Works as agent of the County to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents including, but not limited to, applications, agreements, amendments, purchase orders, payment requests and so on, which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned project, and
3. Authorizes the Director of Public Works to purchase the appropriate product at a cost not to exceed \$10,000, and
4. Authorizes the Director of Public Works to direct operations to connect necessary utilities to the factory manufactured restroom so purchased.
