

RESOLUTION NO. 89-630

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY OF MARIPOSA ESTABLISHING MARIPOSA
UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 1

WHEREAS, a public hearing was called for December 19, 1989, at the hour of 9:30 a.m. in the Board of Supervisors Chambers in the Mariposa County Court House, Mariposa, California, to ascertain whether the public necessity, health, safety or welfare requires the removal of poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures, and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication or similar or associated service, within that certain area of the town described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein.

WHEREAS, notice of such hearing has been given to all affected property owners as shown on the last equalized assessment roll and utilities concerned in the manner and for the time required by law; and

WHEREAS, such hearing has been duly and regularly held, and all persons interested have been given an opportunity to be heard.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mariposa County Board of Supervisors that, pursuant to Chapter 12.12 of the Mariposa County Code, the above described area is hereby declared an Underground Utility District, and is designated as Underground Utility District No. 1 of the County of Mariposa. Attached hereto, marked Exhibit "B" and hereby incorporated as part of this resolution, is a map delineating the boundaries of said District;

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the Board does hereby fix June 1991 as the date on which affected property owners must be ready to receive underground service, and does hereby order the removal of all poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication or similar or associated service within Underground Utility District No. 1 on or before August 1991.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the electric utility which undertakes underground installation of its facilities shall

use the underground conversion allocation computed pursuant to decisions of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California for the purpose of providing to each premises in Underground Utility District No. 1 a maximum of 200 feet of individual electric service trenching and conductor as well as backfill, paving and conduit. Each property owner in Underground Utility District No. 1 shall be responsible for the installation and maintenance of the conduit and termination box located on, under, or within any structure on the premises serviced.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors is hereby instructed to notify all affected utilities and all persons owning real property within Underground Utility District No. 1 of the adoption of this resolution within ten (10) days after the date of such adoption. Said Clerk shall further notify said property owners of the necessity that, if they or any person occupying such property desire to continue to receive electric, communication or other similar or associated service, they or such occupant shall, by the date fixed in this resolution, provide all necessary facility changes on their premises so as to receive such service from the lines of the supplying utility or utilities at a new location, subject to applicable rules, regulations and tariffs of the respective utility or utilities on file with the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California. Such notification shall be made by mailing a copy of this resolution together with a copy of said Chapter 12.12 of the Mariposa County Code, to affected property owners as such are shown on the last equalized assessment roll and to the affected utilities;

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the Mariposa County Board of Supervisors hereby finds as follows:

The Underground Utility District herein created is in the general public interest for the following reason(s):

- (1) "The undergrounding to be accomplished will avoid or eliminate an unusually heavy concentration of overhead distribution facilities;"
- (2) "The streets, roads or rights of way in the District are extensively used by the general public and carry a heavy volume of pedestrian or vehicular traffic;"

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(3) "The said streets, roads or rights of way adjoin or pass through an area of unusual scenic interest to the general public."

PASSED AND ADOPTED by the Mariposa County Board of Supervisors, a political subdivision of the State of California, at a regular meeting held on the 19th day of December, 1989 by the following vote, to wit:

All of that portion of Ninth, Tenth and Bullion Streets in the Town of Mariposa as shown on the map of the Town of Mariposa recorded as map number 314, Mariposa County Records, situated in the Rancho Las Mariposas, T.5 S., R.18 E., M.D.B.&M., County of Mariposa, State of California, and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the most southerly corner of Block 35 being the intersection of the easterly line of Bullion Street with the northerly line of Eighth Street; thence along said northerly line of Eighth Street, south $53^{\circ} 56' 00''$ west, 60.00 feet more or less to the most easterly corner of Block 34, being a point on the westerly line of Bullion Street; thence along said westerly line of Bullion Street the following courses and distances:

north $36^{\circ} 04' 00''$ west, 250.00 feet more or less, along the easterly line of said Block 34, to the most northerly corner of said block 34;

north $36^{\circ} 04' 00''$ west, 50.00 feet more or less, across Ninth Street, to the most easterly corner of Block 38;

north $36^{\circ} 04' 00''$ west, 250.00 feet more or less, along the easterly line of said Block 38, to the most northerly corner of said block 38;

north $36^{\circ} 04' 00''$ west, 50.00 feet more or less, across Tenth Street, to the most easterly corner of Block 42;

north $36^{\circ} 04' 00''$ west, 250.00 feet more or less, along the easterly line of said Block 42, to the most northerly corner of said block 42;

north $36^{\circ} 04' 00''$ west, 50.00 feet more or less, across Eleventh Street, to the most easterly corner of Block 46;

north $36^{\circ} 04' 00''$ west, 125.00 feet along the easterly line of said Block 46 to a point;

thence leaving said westerly line of Bullion Street, north $53^{\circ} 56' 00''$ east, 60.00 feet more or less to a point on the westerly line of Block 47, also being the easterly line of Bullion Street; thence along said easterly line of Bullion Street the following courses and distances:

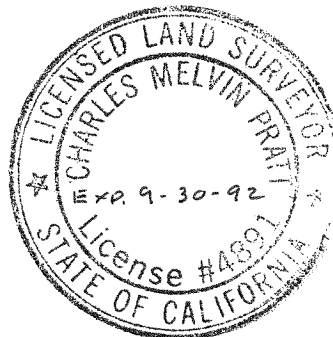
south $36^{\circ} 04' 00''$ east, 125.00 feet along the westerly line of said Block 47, to the most southerly corner of said Block 47;

south $36^{\circ} 04' 00''$ east, 50.00 feet more or less, across Eleventh Street, to the most westerly corner of Block 43;

south 36° 04' 00" east, 250.00 feet more or less along the westerly line of Block 43 to the most southerly corner of said Block 43, being the intersection of the easterly line of Bullion Street with the northerly line of Tenth Street;

thence leaving said easterly line of Bullion Street, north 53° 56' 00" east, 240.00 feet more or less, along the northerly line of Tenth Street, to the most easterly corner of said Block 43, being the intersection of the northerly line of Tenth Street with the westerly line of Jones Street; thence leaving the northerly line of Tenth Street, south 36° 04' 00" east, 50.00 feet more or less, along the westerly line of Jones Street, to the most northerly corner of Block 39, being the intersection of the westerly line of Jones Street with the southerly line of Tenth Street; thence leaving said westerly line of Jones Street, south 53° 56' 00" west, 240.00 feet more or less, along the southerly line of Tenth Street, to the most westerly corner of said Block 39, being the intersection of the southerly line of Tenth Street with the easterly line of Bullion Street; thence leaving the southerly line of Tenth Street and along the easterly line of Bullion Street, south 36° 04' 00" east, 250.00 feet more or less to the most southerly corner of said Block 39, being the intersection of the easterly line of Bullion Street with the northerly line of Ninth Street; thence leaving the easterly line of Bullion Street, north 53° 56' 00" east, 240.00 feet more or less, along the northerly line of Ninth Street, to the most easterly corner of said Block 39, being the intersection of the northerly line of Ninth Street with the westerly line of Jones Street; thence leaving the northerly line of Ninth Street, south 36° 04' 00" east, 50.00 feet more or less, along the easterly line of Jones Street, to the most northerly corner of Block 35, being the intersection of the westerly line of Jones Street with the southerly line of Ninth Street; thence leaving the westerly line of Jones Street, south 53° 56' 00" west, 215.00 feet more or less to a point on the southerly line of Ninth Street, 25.00 feet easterly from the easterly line of Bullion Street as measured along the southerly line of Ninth Street; thence leaving said southerly line of Ninth Street and along a line parallel to and 25.00 feet distant from the easterly line of Bullion Street, south 36° 04' 00" east, 68.00 feet; thence along a line parallel to and 68.00 feet distant from the southerly line of Ninth Street, south 53° 56' 00" west, 25.00 feet more or less to the easterly line of Bullion Street; thence along said easterly line of Bullion Street, south 36° 04' 00" east, 182.00 feet to the most southerly corner of Block 35, being the **Point of Beginning**. All of the above streets and blocks are as shown on above said map of the Town of Mariposa.

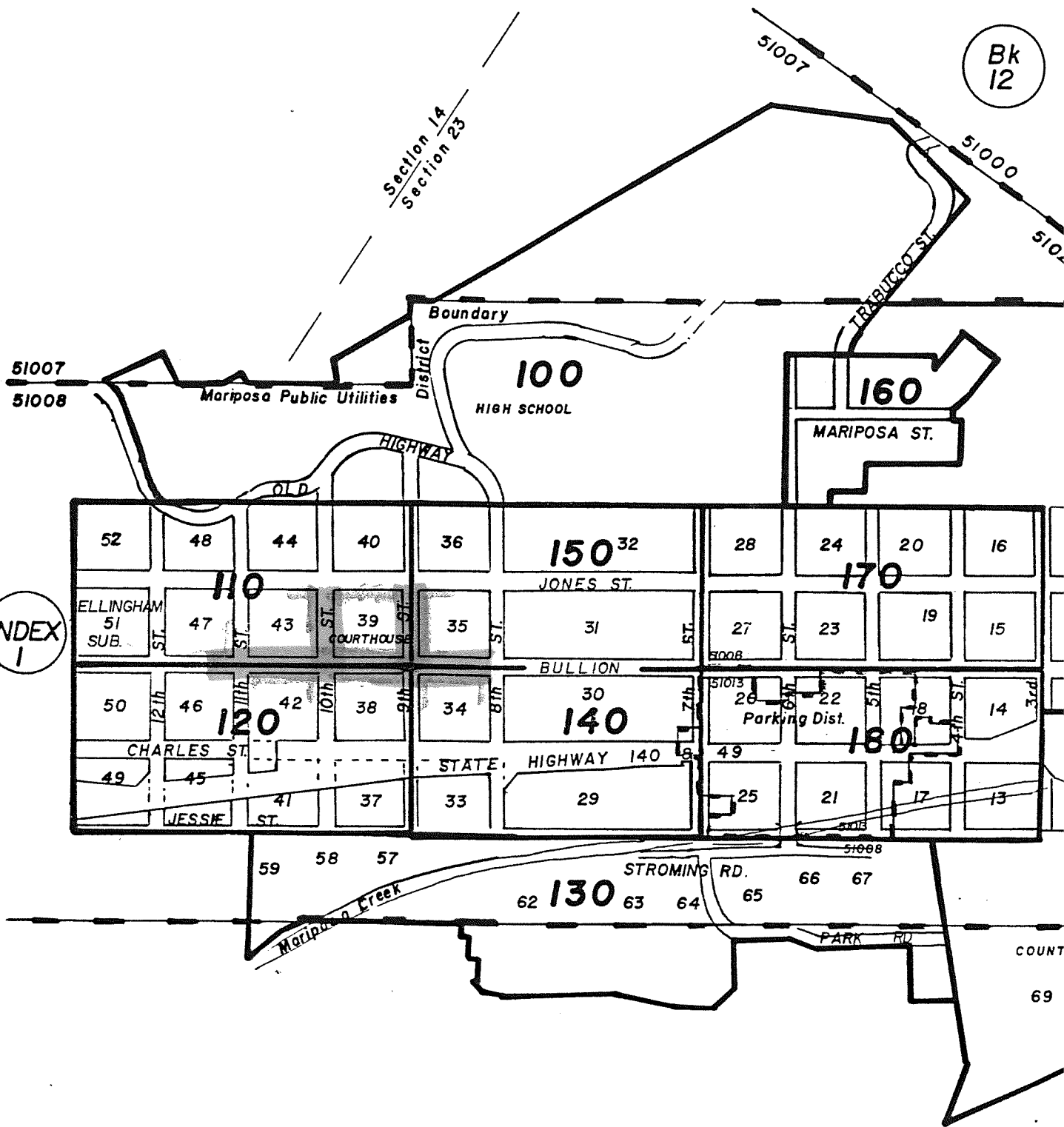
