

MARIPOSA COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 88-119
DECLARING A COUNTY VEHICLE TO BE SURPLUS PROPERTY

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department has requested permission to dispose of an inoperable vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the Vehicle Maintenance Foreman has found the 1965 1/2 ton Chevrolet stepside pickup, VIN #C14452124562, Lic # 152907, to have a value of \$50 or less.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mariposa County Board of Supervisors, a political subdivision of the State of California, that pursuant to Government Code Section 25363, which gives the Board the authority to sell without notice or advertising any surplus property with a value of \$500 or less, said vehicle be declared surplus and to have a value of \$50 or less and;


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Mariposa County Board of Supervisors be allowed to sell said vehicle on behalf of the County.
