A RESOLUTION WAIVING BIDDING PROCEDURE ON PURCHASE OF  
CENTRAL COMPUTER SYSTEM


WHEREAS, informal quotes and bids were received from all vendors concerned for a central computer system; and

WHEREAS, the market was exhausted and the Basic Four MPX 9410 system was found to be more compatible with existing programs and equipment; and was found to be acceptable with regards to warranty and maintenance.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mariposa County Board of Supervisors, a political subdivision of the State of California, that the Board finds it in the best public interest to waive the bidding procedure for this system; and hereby authorizes the Data Processing Coordinator to purchase the Basic Four MPX 9410 computer and peripheral equipment as recommended.

PASSED AND ADOPTED this 12th day of April, 1988, by the Mariposa County Board of Supervisors by the following vote:


