A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF FOSTER CARE PLACEMENT OPTIONS FOR
CHILDREN

WHEREAS, a critical shortage of available placement options for abused, neglected and orphaned children exists, and


WHEREAS, the state claims that placement with extended family members is preferred, and

WHEREAS, the state currently discriminates between state AFDC-FC eligible children in foster care who are placed with relatives and state AFDC-FC eligible children who are placed with non-relatives.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mariposa County Board of Supervisors, a political subdivision of the State of California, supports AB 3500, which addresses this inequity and will allow a relative to receive foster care payments even if the child does not meet federal eligibility criteria.
