

MARIPOSA COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 88-255

A RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE YOSEMITE PARK AND CURRY COMPANY  
FOR THEIR ACTION PHASING OUT POLYSTYRENE PRODUCTS

WHEREAS, the action of the Yosemite Park and Curry Company phasing out polystyrene products, will help extend the life of the Mariposa County Landfill by reducing the amount of nondegradable waste sent to the landfill; and

WHEREAS, reducing Polystyrene products will reduce litter, extend the life of landfills, and may help to protect the atmosphere from ozone depletion and the Greenhouse effect; and

WHEREAS, the action by the Yosemite Park and Curry Company is particularly important in the county where tourism, which is dependent on a quality environment, is the key to our economy.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mariposa County Board of Supervisors a political subdivision of the State of California, that the Yosemite Park and Curry Company be commended for demonstrating, by this action, their concern for preserving a quality environment.
