

RESOLUTION NO. 88- 403

RESOLUTION ADOPTING A NEGATIVE DECLARATION ON SPECIFIC PLAN
NO. 88-1, TIM MANLY, APPLICANT.

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act and Mariposa County Resolution No. 86-151 require that environmental review be performed on projects; and,

WHEREAS, an Initial Study has been prepared for Specific Plan No. 88-1; and,

WHEREAS, said Initial Study identifies effects the project may have on the environment and describes mitigation measures which adequately address all identified environmental effects, and the applicants have agreed to incorporate these mitigation measures into the project proposal as conditions of approval, and these measures will mitigate identified environmental effects entirely or to an acceptable level; and,

WHEREAS, a public review period has been held, and no public comments or request for hearing received in accordance with State law and Mariposa County Environmental Review Policies and Procedures.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors hereby determines that the project will not have a significant effect on the environment. A Negative Declaration is hereby adopted.




