

MARIPOSA COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 88-444

A RESOLUTION FINDING THAT A CONTRACT FOR BID OPENING NO. 88-6 CAN BE NEGOTIATED FOR A LOWER PRICE THAN IN ANY OF THE BIDS

WHEREAS, the Public Works Director has advised that bids received for Coulterville/El Portal tennis court resurfacing were analyzed and it was found that none fit within the specifications of the plans nor within the budgeted amount for the project; and

WHEREAS, by Mariposa County Resolution No. 88-443, the Board of Supervisors rejected all bids received for the second bid opening (No. 88-6) held for this project; and


WHEREAS, the Public Works Director has recommended that a contract can be negotiated at a lower price than that in any of the bids for BID OPENING NO. 88-6;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mariposa County Board of Supervisors, a political subdivision of the State of California, that the Board declares that in it's opinion a contract to perform the project can be negotiated at a lower price than that in any of the bids; and that authorization be given to begin negotiations pursuant to Public Contracts Code Section 20150.10.
