

MARIPOSA COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 88-476

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE AGRICULTURAL COMMISSIONER TO SELL VERTEBRATE PEST CONTROL MATERIALS AND RESCINDING AND REPLACING RESOLUTION NO. 82-109

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 82-109 set forth a schedule of charges for for the resale of vertebrate pest control materials; and

WHEREAS, the cost to the County of vertebrate pest control materials fluctuates.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mariposa County Board of Supervisors, a political subdivision of the State of California, that Resolution No. 82-109 is hereby rescinded and replaced in its entirety.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Agricultural Commissioner shall have the power and authority to sell vertebrate pest control materials. All such materials shall be furnished at cost plus to any person upon satisfactory assurance to the Agricultural Commissioner that such materials are to be used on premises within the county for the purpose of controlling and destroying or eradicating said vertebrate pests.


