A RESOLUTION IN RECOGNITION OF JACK D. "SCOTT" PINKERTON
FOR SERVICES AS MARIPOSA COUNTY "COURTHOUSE HISTORIAN"

WHEREAS, Jack D. "Scott" Pinkerton has and continues to serve Mariposa County as the "Courthouse Historian"; and

WHEREAS, Jack D. "Scott" Pinkerton initiated a thorough examination of the County archives and records to compile the most comprehensive research documentation on the history of the Mariposa County Courthouse; and

WHEREAS, "Scott" Pinkerton has been recognized by the State Office of Historic Preservation for the recent publication of his Mariposa County Courthouse Historical Structures Report; and

WHEREAS, "Scott's" research documentation represents an invaluable data source for future historical interpretation of the courthouse; and
