WHEREAS, the Associated Student Body of Mariposa County High School desires to form a "Sister School" relationship with a school in the Soviet Union; and


WHEREAS, the Associated Student Body of Mariposa County High School is the first student government organization in the United State to undertake such an effort; and

WHEREAS, Congressman Tony Coelho has given his wholehearted endorsement to this endeavor.


