

Resolution No. 88-596

A RESOLUTION ALLOWING THE
COUNTY TAX COLLECTOR TO COLLECT
PARTIAL PAYMENTS AND THE COUNTY
AUDITOR TO CHARGE DELINQUENT PENALTY
ON THE BALANCE DUE


BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors deems it to be in the best interest of the public to allow the County Tax Collector to accept partial payments on Secured, Unsecured, and Supplemental taxes in accordance with Chapter 2, Section 2601-2636, Chapter 2.1, Section 2700-2708, Chapter 2.2, Section 2750-2772, or Chapter 4, Section 2901-2929 of the Revenue & Taxation Code.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Tax Collector has discretionary authority to accept such tax in an amount not less than \$10.00, or 25% of the tax due, whichever is greater.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Auditor has the authority to charge the Tax Collector with penalties remaining on the unpaid tax in accordance with law.
