

MARIPOSA COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 88-600

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A POLICY FOR CONSIDERATION OF INCREASES IN THE COMPENSATION RATE FOR BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has considered the annual compensation rate for members of the Board of Supervisors; and


WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has considered establishing a policy for consideration of future increases in the compensation rate;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mariposa County Board of Supervisors, a political subdivision of the State of California, that the following policy be established for consideration of any future scheduled increases for members of the Board of Supervisors:

Commencing July 1, 1989, and on each July 1st, thereafter the schedule for all future compensation rates for the chairman and members of the Board of Supervisors should be considered based upon twenty-five percent (25%) of the compensation rate established by the California State Legislature for superior court judges in the State of California as that rate exists on June 30th of the previous fiscal year.
