

A RESOLUTION COMMENDING ERVIN LEROY RADANOVICH FOR HIS SERVICE TO MARIPOSA COUNTY AS SUPERVISOR FROM DISTRICT IV

WHEREAS, ERVIN LEROY RADANOVICH, prior to being elected to the Mariposa County Board of Supervisors, served the community as a businessman, pharmacist, photographer, community leader, and as a volunteer firefighter. As Mariposa County's "Official Photographer" LEROY donated his services on many occasions; and

WHEREAS, ERVIN LEROY RADANOVICH, promoted the development of the Self-Esteem Task Force, served as President of the Chamber of Commerce, worked on the Highway 140 Association, served as President of the Lions Club; and

WHEREAS, ERVIN LEROY RADANOVICH, was elected and served as Supervisor representing Supervisorial District IV in Mariposa County from January 1985 through December 1988; and

WHEREAS, LEROY served as Chairman of the Mariposa County Board of Supervisors in 1987; and

WHEREAS, ERVIN LEROY RADANOVICH, has been interested in encouraging all the citizens of Mariposa County to have a voice in their local government, he has served on the following Board Committees: Natural Resources, Road Improvement Standards and Circulation Policy, Airport Land Use, Mariposa Parking District; and

WHEREAS, LEROY served as Chairman of the Mariposa County Water Agency from January 1985, through December 1988; and because of his concern for adequate quality and quantity of water for the present and future, he has used his expertise to advise the Water Agency Advisory Board; actively served in State and Mountain Counties organizations to develop and conserve water resources and protect water rights for counties of origin; been instrumental in developing a water supply for Mariposa County from the Merced River; and

WHEREAS, LEROY represented the interests of Mariposa County and surrounding counties by participating in and serving as President of the San Joaquin Valley Supervisors Association in 1988; and

WHEREAS, LEROY responded to the community by serving on the Committee which worked to create the Mariposa County Fire Department, uniting the volunteer fire fighting units, and upgrading the County's fire protection plan; and

WHEREAS, LEROY worked to resolve emergency medical issues, particularly the ambulance service to provide for an efficient service on a Countywide basis; and

WHEREAS, LEROY has actively pursued a course which upgraded the operation of each Department in the County, including re-organization of the Public Works Department, expanding the County's Public Health Office, upgrading the County's Central Computer System, worked on the Space Needs Master Plan, upgrading of library services, promoted and worked to establish Mariposa County's first administrative junction and the hiring of the County's first Administrative Officer - John W. McComman; and


WHEREAS, LEROY has participated in the restoration of the County Courthouse with a particular interest in preserving the historic integrity of the building; and


WHEREAS, LEROY has worked to establish the GAIN Program under the direction of the Welfare Director to provide work opportunities for all citizens of Mariposa County; and

WHEREAS, LEROY anticipated the future economic needs of the County with the establishment of tourism and economic development programs and support of the Chamber of Commerce; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mariposa County Board of Supervisors, a political subdivision of the State of California, that ERVIN LEROY RADANOVICH be commended for his service to the County as Supervisor of District IV.
