



- (b) Describe the County's procedure and criteria for selection of the panel of Independent Certification Review Hearing Officers.

Because of the small size of the program and limited staffing, the hearing officers are the clinical lead positions in the Madera and Mariposa programs. Mariposa has no in-patient facilities and patients are hospitalized in Fresno which is 75 miles away. Mariposa has made arrangements with Madera County to use their hearing process when W&I 5250 hearings are required. Both Madera and Mariposa contract with the same in-patient facility.

- (c) Describe the County's method for funding and training of Hearing Officers.

The Hearing Officers take advantage of training opportunities provided by the State. The training is funded through County Short-Doyle funds.
