

1 MARIPOSA COUNTY RESOLUTION No. 83-322

2 A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION
3 FOR RENOVATING AND UPGRADING THE COUNTY JAIL FACILITY

4 WHEREAS, Mariposa County desires to apply to the State of Cali-
5 formia for the sum of TWO HUNDRED THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED SEVENTY DOLLARS
6 AND TWENTY-FIVE CENTS (\$250,670.25), under the provisions of
7 Chapter 34 of the Statutes of 1982 (SB 910) as codified in Sections
8 4400 through 4422 of Chapters 1 through 2 of Title 4.5 of Part 3
9 of the California Penal Code entitled "County Jail Capital Expen-
10 diture Bond Act of 1981" in the amount and for the purpose and
11 duration set forth in that application, for the purpose of reno-
12 vating and up-grading the Mariposa County Jail, and

13 WHEREAS, Mariposa County must provide certain matching
14 funds in the event the application is granted, and

15 WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the citizens of
16 Mariposa County to renovate and up-grade the County Jail Facility,
17 and

18 WHEREAS, Mariposa County has exhausted all other avail-
19 able means of raising the requested funds for the renovation and
20 up-grading of the County Jail Facility.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Super-
22 visors of Mariposa County as follows:

23 1. Mariposa County is hereby directed to
24 submit an application to the State of California requesting
25 funds to renovate and up-grade the Mariposa County Jail
26 Facility for the following reasons:

27 a. Mariposa County is now, and has been since
28 Proposition 13, using its full allowable tax rate.

1 b. Mariposa County has attempted to obtain other
2 funding for the renovation and up-grading of the County
3 Jail Facility and has obtained funding through AB 90
4 for a Work Furlough Program.

5 c. Mariposa County has no contingency or reserve
6 funds available that could reasonably be used to reduce
7 the funds requested from the State.

8 d. Mariposa County has attempted to obtain
9 funds for the renovation and upgrading of the County
10 Jail Facility from the United States Marshall, however,
11 no funds were available.


12 e. Mariposa County has exhausted all other
13 resources for funding thereby necessitating this appli-
14 cation to the State for assistance.

15 2. If the Application for State funds is granted, the
16 Board of Supervisors will appropriate the required hard and
17 soft matching funds.

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors
19 that ERIC J. ERICKSON, Chairman of the Board, is hereby authorized
20 to execute any and all documents necessary to have the application
21 filed with the State and is further authorized to execute this
22 resolution.


