A G R E E M E N T

2 This Agreement, made as of May 4, 1982, between the
3 COUNTY OF AGREEMENT, a political subdivision of the State of
4 California, hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY", and Mrs. Jennie
5 Enos, a married woman, hereinafter referred to as "SALVAGER".

STATEMENT OF CONTRACT

7 COUNTY is presently operating a sanitary landfill operation
8 located adjacent to Highway 49 North, Mariposa, California. In
9 order to provide maximum effectiveness in the use of the sanitary
10 landfill site, it is necessary to avoid the placing of salvageable
11 material which has recyclable value. Therefore, it is the intent
12 of COUNTY to contract for the separation of these items and pro-
13 vide for the salvage thereof.

14 1. SALVAGER shall inspect refuse entering the sanitary land-
15 fill site to insure that all items of salvage value are deposited
16 in the area designated for the storage of said items and that no
17 such items be deposited in those areas reserved for defense.

18 2. All sheet steel or "tin" material shall be the property
19 and under the control of the COUNTY after it is placed in the des-
20 ignated storage area by SALVAGER.

21 3. SALVAGER shall insure that all items salvaged shall be
22 removed from the sanitary landfill site within sixty days of its
23 being salvaged.

24 4. COUNTY confirms that payment to SALVAGER the sum of Four
25 Hundred Seventy-Five Dollars (\$475.00) per month during the period
26 of this Agreement. Further, SALVAGER shall receive as additional
27 compensation all rights to any profits derived from the sale of
28 said salvage except the sheet steel or "tin" material which shall

1 be the property of COUNTY.

2 5. The terms of this Agreement shall be for one year com-
3 mencing on May 1, 1982 and terminating April 30, 1983. Either
4 party may terminate this Agreement by giving thirty days' written
5 notice to the other party.

6 6. SALVAGER shall be responsible for performing the work
7 under this Agreement in a safe, skillful, and workmanlike manner
8 and shall be liable for her own negligence.

9 7. This instrument embodies the whole agreement of the
10 parties. There are no promises, terms, conditions, or obligations
11 other than those contained herein; and this contract shall super-
12 sede all previous communications, representations, or agreements,
13 either verbal or written, between the parties.
