NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

**PROPOSED ADOPTION OF THE DISTRICT'S OZONE EMERGENCY
EPISODE PLAN**

Pursuant to Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations (40 CFR) Part 51, Subpart 51.102, the Mariposa County Air Pollution Control District (District) is advising the public and affected individuals, and agencies of its plan to adopt an Ozone Emergency Episode Plan (OEEP). As part of the Infrastructure State Implementation Plan (SIP) requirements pursuant to Section 110(a) of the federal Clean Air Act, those air districts or States which are designated nonattainment for the 2015 8-hour Ozone National Ambient Air Quality Standard must adopt an OEEP. The OEEP is intended to provide contingency measures when Ozone concentrations reach levels that could endanger public health. These measures include, but are not limited to: Ozone trigger levels; notification procedures; and, actions to reduce emissions from mobile and stationary sources when an Ozone emergency episode is declared.

The Board of Supervisors sitting as the District Board of Directors will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, April 7, 2020, at 9am or as soon thereafter as possible, at the Mariposa County Board of Supervisors Chambers, 5100 Bullion Street, Mariposa, California.

In addition, all interested parties are advised of the opportunity to comment in writing on the proposed action.
