NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Project: Mariposa County Creative Placemaking Strategy
Proponent: County of Mariposa

Project Description: In partnership with the Mariposa County Arts Council, the Mariposa County Planning Department received a grant from the National Endowment's Our Town program to support the development of a countywide Creative Placemaking Strategy. This project used interactive and collaborative stakeholder engagement to develop a plan document to promote a rich and compelling rural economy. The Strategy recommends projects, programs, and policies to:

- Promote a portfolio of authentic, engaging experiences that encourage tourists to stay in--rather than simply pass through--Mariposa enroute to Yosemite.
- Increase community attachment and civic engagement by promoting placemaking projects that are more representative of Mariposa's diverse and rich identity;
- Integrate creative placemaking efforts into existing and future infrastructure and other community assets.

If you challenge the final action of the Board of Supervisors on the Creative Placemaking Strategy in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, the Board of Supervisors public hearing, or in written correspondence delivered to the Board of Supervisors at, or prior to, the public hearings.

Written comments may be made and submitted at any time during the public review period up to, and including, the public portion of the public hearing time. Letters or written comments submitted after the public input time of the public hearing will become part of the file documents but will not become part of the record unless the public input time is reopened.
